

DRESS CODE POLICY AT A GLANCE

All students (1-12)	
Pants/shorts/skirts	Tan, navy blue, black in color. Denim, sweat suit, leather, velour, frayed edges, and "low-rider" styles are not permissible. Belts at all times. Length of shorts should not be more than 3 inches from middle of the knee.
Jackets/coats	MJCA sweatshirts allowed in the classroom. Trench coats, jackets, outerwear are not permissible in classrooms.
Hair	Clean and neat. Unusually shaved or spiked not allowed. Color must be consistent of natural hair colors.
Miscellaneous	Hats, bandannas, visible tattoos are not permissible.
Formal Wear	Modest in appearance.

Elementary students (1-5)	
Shirts	MJCA logo shirts are optional. Must wear polo-style, button-down or turtleneck shirts. Polo-style/turtleneck must be white, navy blue, red, royal blue or dark green with collars. Button-downs can be solid white or light blue. Brand name labels must be no larger than a standard business card. Solid white t-shirts underneath. Long or short sleeves. Tucked in at all times. No more than two buttons may be left unbuttoned at neck.
Pullovers/vests/cardigans/sweatshirts	Solid white, navy blue, red or dark green. May purchase MJCA logo sweatshirts from PTO.

Secondary students (6-12)	
Shirts	MJCA logo shirts only. Purchased through MJCA. Available in polo-style (short sleeve or long sleeve), or turtleneck. Button-downs are also available. Solid white t-shirts underneath. Tucked in at all times. No more than two buttons may be left unbuttoned at neck.
Pullovers/sweatshirts	Must be MJCA logo brand. Available through PTO. Do not have to wear a uniform shirt underneath MJCA sweatshirts.

Violations	
Options:	
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Student may call home to have parent bring a change of clothes. 2. Student will be given articles of clothing to wear (if available).
