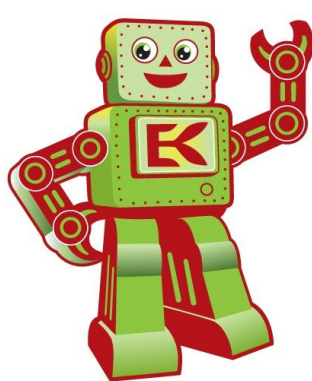
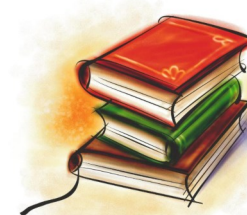

Teacher must have an Early Ed. or Elementary teaching degree. Must be willing to pursue ACSI Teacher Certification while working for MJCA and maintain certification. Teacher will be required to write and submit daily lesson plans, assist with curriculum guides, complete student assessments, and other assigned tasks. This position requires additional yearly training hours as mandated by the state. The applicant must be physically able to work with young children and pass all necessary background checks. Experience working in a Pre-K setting preferred.

Full-time MIDDLE SCHOOL MATH TEACHER must have a Bachelor's Degree in education and/or related to subject. Must be willing to pursue ACSI Teacher Certification while working for MJCA and maintain certification. Teacher will be required to write and submit daily lesson plans, assist with curriculum guides, complete student assessments, and other assigned tasks. This position requires additional yearly training hours as mandated by the State. The applicant must pass all necessary background checks. Experience preferred.

Full-time SECONDARY PHYSICAL EDUCATION TEACHER must have a Bachelor's Degree in education and/or related to subject. Must be willing to pursue ACSI Teacher Certification while working for MJCA and maintain certification. Teacher will be required to write and submit daily lesson plans, assist with curriculum guides, complete student assessments, and other assigned tasks. This position requires additional yearly training hours as mandated by the State. The applicant must be physically able to work with students and pass all necessary background checks.
