

5 Day Pre-K4 Supply List

Please label these supplies:

- \$30 Technology Fee
- 1 plastic school box for crayons, markers, and pencils
- 12 glue sticks and 2 small glue bottles
- 2 boxes of Crayola Crayons (24 count traditional colors)
- 2 boxes **fat** washable markers (10 count **CLASSIC** colors)
- 1 pair of Fiskars children's scissors – rounded, not pointed ends
- 1 Water Color Paint Set (Traditional)
- 2 plastic 2-pocket folder for worksheets, art, notes, etc. which go home daily
- 1 3-ring Binder (1" size)
- 2 Spiral notebooks. Wide-ruled. 200 pages.
- 1 overly large old T-shirt labeled with child's name for use as a paint shirt.
- Students need a fitted crib sheet and blanket for nap. Students may bring a small pillow or small stuffed animal for nap as well. (These will stay at school Monday-Friday).

Please bring daily:

- Backpack (**no** rolling backpacks) should be large enough to put 8 ½" x 11" papers
- 1 change of clothes in backpack (spills & accidents do happen), put in gallon ziplock bag and place inside backpack.
- Water bottle with spill-proof lid (that closes) filled with water for your child EACH DAY. They need the water and bringing it for them to have in the room provides easy access at the table during table-work time. Please do not send any other type of drink.
- Daily snack and lunch (peanut free). Milk/Juice allowed in lunch.

- 1 Package Baby Wipes
- 1 package of 9" paper plates
- 1 package of Expo markers
- 1 box of tissues
- 2 rolls of paper towels
- 1 box of boy band-aids

Girls:

- 1 package of gallon size ziplock bags

- 2 rolls of paper towels
- 1 roll of Mauvelous tape (found at the teacher store or amazon.com)
- 1 box of girl band-aids
