We are excited to have Saints Club Summer Care on campus for summer 2022! Students will have fun activities each day, weekly themes, inflatables, special guests, and more! Spots are limited and will be given on a first-come-first-serve basis.

When: June 1 - July 29, 2022 | 7:00 AM - 6:00 PM. Morning care is available and begins at 6:00 AM.
Saints Club will be closed July 4-8 and there will be no summer care.

Cost: \$1,600/student for rising 2's through 5th grade. A non-refundable \$100 deposit is required to secure your spot and the remaining balance will be evenly split/automatically drafted on May 27, 2022 and June 24, 2022. Morning care beginning at 6:00 AM will be available for an additional \$200 and will be added to the drafts.

SUMMER CARE DETAILS | 2022

Schedule:

When: June 1 - July 29, 2022 | 7:00 AM - 6:00 PM. Morning care is available and begins at 6:00 AM. **Saints Club will be closed July 4-8 and there will be no summer care.** Summer Care begins at 7:00 AM.

Drop Off:

Students should be delivered to the Children's Building by a parent or an adult over the age of 18. Parents must enter the building with their child and sign their child in. Children should never enter the building without an adult chaperone.

Weather Info:

If the temperature is above 95 degrees or below 32 degrees, if it is raining, or if there is a threat of severe weather we will remain inside. To help assist you in knowing if your child is inside or on the outside a sign will be placed outside of the Children's Building Lobby.

Behavior:

There are few instances in which a child's behavior warrants suspension from Summer Care for up to three days. These offenses include, but are not limited to: fighting, deliberate and repeated rudeness and disrespect to a Saints Club Worker, and excessive and continued disregard for Saints Club rules. Suspension from Saints Club will be used only if deemed necessary by the Saints Club Director and Administration for one of the above offenses. Every attempt will be made to solve the problem before it reaches the point of suspension. If suspension is necessary, the parent will be given one day's notice. The student may not remain in Saints Club for any reason during the suspension. Upon return, the student will be on probation for a grading period. Repetition of the cause for suspension may result in permanent expulsion from the program.

Late Fee:

Saints Club is staffed through 6:00 PM. Your child must be picked up before that time. Failure to do so will result in a late fee. The late fee schedule is as follows: There will be two grace periods of up to 5 minutes late. Beyond 5 minutes (or the two grace periods), there will be a charge of \$5.00 per child for every minute late.
